Basic Things Parents Need To Know About Camp

Please take a few minutes to discuss camp behavior expectations with your child before camp starts. More information on Camp can be found on the Pool website.

- HOP rules are like school rules and include the following: hands, feet, objects to themselves, use of appropriate language, and kindness towards others. Threats, theft, vandalism will not be tolerated.
- Campers must ask permission to leave the designated camp area (includes pool facility, hall, playgrounds). Cooperation & courtesy is expected towards leaders, lifeguards, other campers and pool patrons.
- Bring a nut-free lunch, snack and a water bottle daily. \$5.00 or less is suggested for concession purchases if child is allowed to choose items during afternoon swim.
- Remember to include spray sunscreen, insect repellant, hat, towel, swimsuit etc. in your back- pack. Children are responsible for applying own sunscreen. Leaders will assist if requested.
- Please label all belongings to help ensure their return in case of loss. Valuables should remain at home. HOP will not be held responsible for lost, broken or stolen items.
- \$0.25 non-return coin lockers are available for use at the pool.
- There is a Lost & Found drop located in the foyer at Highwood Outdoor Pool and in the coat check area at the Highwood Community Hall. Items will be kept until Sept. 5th then disposed or donated.
- Children should wear high activity footwear and clothing to camp. Water shoes are a great option for lengthy water play.

Children should not be sent to camp if they are exhibiting the following:

- Illness that prevents them from participating comfortably in all camp activities.
- Fever, undiagnosed rash or symptoms such as lethargy, constant crying, difficulty breathing, diarrhea or vomiting.

If children come to camp ill, or become ill after arriving at camp, parents will be called to pick them up.

Health

- 1. If my child is too sick to participate comfortably in the program, I will not send him/her to camp. I agree to pick up my child in a timely manner if they become ill after their arrival at camp.
- 2. I agree that the Day Camp and Pool staff, in the event of an emergency, may use their reasonable discretion on behalf of my/our child(ren), including rendering first aid treatment and/or arranging for emergency medical care.

 I understand and agree emergency medical care secured for the health and safety of my child will be at my expense.

Refund, Transfer and Medical Policy

- 1. Refunds will be made by community cheque and can require up to a 30-day grace to issue. Refunds will not be made through the pool office. If HOP Day Camp cancels the program for any reason, camper may transfer to another week or receive a full refund. Withdrawals must be dated and submitted in writing to a Camp Leader or Pool Manager. Notification of withdrawal must be received a minimum 72 hours before 1st day of camp in order to receive a full refund minus a \$25.00 admin fee. Withdrawal within 72 hours of the 1st day of camp, receives a CREDIT (no refund) for camp fee for 2017 season only, so that the child may enjoy camp another week.

 After camp start, or failure to show up there will be no refund or fee credit. Refunds will not be issued for children dismissed from camp, or withdrawn after parents were notified verbally or in writing about continuing behavior issues.
- 2. Transfer Policy: Campers may change from one type of camp to another in the same week. If hours are increased, extra time will be charged. No refunds are given for decrease.
- 3. Medical Refund Policy: Withdrawals are given with no penalty prior to start of camp with a Dr's note. After start of camp with a Dr.s note, the refund or transfer will be prorated. No admin fee will be charged.

Drop-Off, Pick-Up and Absenteeism Policy

- 1. I understand that parents are given a 5-minute grace for drop off or pick-up times and arrivals outside of those times will be charged the before/after care fee. I understand that there is no grace time for before/after care.
- 2. I will not drop off or leave camper unattended outside the pool, park, hall, or playgrounds. I will sign them in and out of day camp each day unless alternate arrangements have been made with a Day Camp Leader.
- 3. If my child is leaving early or will be arriving late, I will attempt to notify camp staff in advance. Messages for Day Camp Leaders can be left at the pool office by calling 403-221-3574.
- 4. In the event of late arrivals, absenteeism due to illness, vacation, etc., I understand I am still responsible for full cost of the program in which registered. Due to ratios, missed swim instruction will not be made up.

 Photo Release
- 1. I grant permission for Day Camp and Pool staff to take and publish still photographs, videos, or publish those previously taken of my child. This media will remain the property of the pool and may be used by HOP Day Camp for the purpose of displays, promotion, and marketing with no compensation to my child or me.
- 2. Due to the public nature of the HOP facility I am aware that other parents or patrons may be taking photos of their children, and at times my child may inadvertently be included in this media.

Sunscreen / Insect Repellent

Campers are responsible for providing & applying their own spray sunscreen and insect repellent. Please send to camp in the original container labeled with child's name on it. Staff will assist if a camper asks for help.

Behavior

I understand that it is my child's responsibility to follow the rules set for campers by pool and camp staff. Campers are expected to contribute to an atmosphere of respect, safety, friendship, kindness, patience and cooperation at all times. It should be shown to leaders, lifeguards, other campers, and pool patrons. Those who continuously become disruptive or seriously diminish the experience of other campers will be sent home. Expulsion can be for reasons of violence, theft, intentionally damaging property, bullying, consistently refusing to obey Staff, follow pool rules, or the ongoing use of foul language.

Excursions & Swim Instruction

- 1. It is the parent's responsibility to indicate their child's swim ability. If no level is listed, campers will be assessed during the first day of camp and placed in a teaching group that has space availability closest to their assessed level.
- 2. I give permission for my child to go on walking excursions off the Highwood Outdoor Pool or Highwood Community Association site. Excursions may include visits to local parks or playgrounds within a few blocks radius.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT AND ASSUMPTION OF RISK

- 1. I acknowledge that I am aware of the details of day camp activities and that there is a possibility of personal risk, damage or serious injury in the day camp activities and willingly agree to assume responsibility for those risks as a condition of registering my minor child for the day camp program.
- 2. I am aware that by allowing my child to participate in the activity of Swimming and Daycamp I will be exposing my child to the following inherent risks, including but not limited to: Falls in dressing room or on the pool deck especially while entering or exiting the pool or wading pool areas or water; sudden immersion, making contact with the pool structure, toys, pool deck/and or other participants visible or non-visible, drowning, or body entrapment in/under equipment, skimmers or flotation devices supplied by Highwood Outdoor Pool or other participants of the facility.
- 3. I understand that HOP will not be held responsible for theft, vandalism, damage or loss of personal property.

INDEMNIFICATION & RELEASE

- 1. I hereby represent that my minor child has no restriction which would prohibit their participation in the Day Camp that I have selected. I, the undersigned parent/guardian, on behalf of myself, my heirs, legalees, and assigns agree to indemnify, save and hold harmless Highwood Outdoor Pool, its agents, directors, representatives, employees or assigns for my child's health, safety, any injury and/or disability arising out of or resulting from the program
- 2. I agree to hold harmless and indemnify Highwood Outdoor Pool, its employees, directors or agents from all liability for damages to property of or personal injury of any third party resulting from my child's participation in this activity.
